2020 Hole format will be the same as 2019 (Attached or on the website at ([www. billbannock.com](http://www.billbannock.com)))

**Superhole areas** are defined as AB1to AB5, B, BC1 to BC5,C, CD1 To CD5, D , DE1 to DE5, E, EF1 to EF5, and F

**Groups** are Earlybird ticket holders that have chosen to fish together.

All Earlybird ticket holders will be drawn and placed in for a Superhole

**NEW – Group ticket sales**

You will be able to buy tickets as a group. ONLY Earlybird ticket holders may be part of a Group.

A Group will be a min of two (2) and maximum of ten (10)----anyone buying 2 or more tickets will be considered a group

When the first member of the group purchases their early bird ticket they should request a group number. All members of the group use the same number

-a paper ticket vendor will give you the Group number

-on line sales- you will be emailed a Group number

-your paper ticket(s) will have the Group number recorded

-a Group may be added to or changed at any time until March 17th to the maximum of 10.

-the **Bill Bannock committee are the only ones that can make changes to the Group numbers**

-once the Group number is given- **Vendors cannot make changes-**

-Earlybird and Group sales will end on MARCH 17th- there will be no additions to any Group after that time.

You do not have to fish in your Superhole Areas. You may go to any of the regular holes. You cannot change Group selected areas.

NOTE: It is best if you buy as many tickets as you can for your group in the beginning. This will help in the control and bookwork. **The first person assigned the Group number will be the contact person for that Group**

**NOTE:**

**You do not have to buy your ticket at the same location the Group was started**

NOTE: When the draw is made for a Superhole area- one name will be drawn – if it is a Group – then the rest of the Group will go to that area.

NOTE: When we do the draw- a single ticket holder or small Groups will go to the location drawn (until that Superhole area has reached a maximum of 10)

NOTE: Holes in a Superhole area are on a first come –first served basis. The ticket numbers on the sign for a Superhole area are the only ones allowed in that area.

Note: There may be more than one Group in a Superhole Area. i.e 2 Groups of 4 and 1 Group of 2

The results will be posted on the website and at the vendors ASAP after the draw.
